

Determining 2010 Deer Season Hunter Registration Order

Dear FHL Deer Hunters,

A lottery system will be used each Friday of the general deer season to determine position in line for registration in a fair and simple way for parties of up to six hunters. This is not a training area reservation system.

Lottery cards will be issued at the registration center for each party of 1 to 6 hunters from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm each Friday. Only one party member needs to be present to enter all party members on one card. All individual party members will be identified by **FIRST AND LAST NAME** and **HUNTING LICENSE NUMBER** on the card and turned into the registration center by 2:00 pm.

**EACH HUNTER MAY APPLY ON ONLY ONE LOTTERY CARD!
HUNTERS SUBMITTING MORE THAN ONE LOTTERY CARD WILL BE
DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL 2010 LOTTERY DRAWINGS!**

Each lottery cards (FHL and Hunter copy) will have a unique identification number, all party member names, and hunting license numbers.

A computer generated drawing will be conducted by 2:30 pm to randomly order all party numbers.

The randomly ordered list of party numbers will be posted for the hunters, and registration will start with the first random party number beginning at 3:00 pm.

Party members present will be registered into their training area of choice when the party number is called (junior hunters are accepted and a junior party slot will be held no later than 7:00 am Saturday morning). Whole parties and party members not present when the party number is called will be sent to the end of the "sweat line" (meaning the line of hunters waiting for the lottery to finish) when they arrive.

Party groups will be registered into one training area and not split between training areas.

Vacant training area slots remaining after the lottery registration is completed will be awarded on a first come first served basis for the remainder of the weekend.
