

2014/15 FORT HUNTER LIGGETT PERMIT APPLICATION

How the Permit Process Works

- Step 1. You send us a completed **2014/15 FHL PERMIT APPLICATION** and a **COPY OF YOUR VALID 2014/15 CALIFORNIA HUNTING LICENSE** by mail. Use of a previous year's or incomplete application will delay processing your application.
- Step 2. You must include the correct fee in a money order or cashier's check payable only to the **"MWR US ARMY"**. No personal checks accepted.
- Step 3. You provide an e-mail address or self addressed, stamped envelop for confirmation.
- Step 4. We will process your application within two weeks of postmark date.
- Step 5. We will notify you by e-mail or mail that your application is processed.
- Step 6. You pick up your permit in person with current photo identification at the Outdoor Recreation Hunting and Fishing check station on Fort Hunter Liggett.


Other Important Information

- Your 2014-15 annual hunting permit is valid from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015 concurrent with the California hunting license year.
- Your 2014-15 two-day hunting permit is valid for any one weekend from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.
- Your permit application is not a reservation for hunting on a weekend.
- **Incomplete, Incorrect, or Illegible Applications will be Rejected.**
- Access for hunting in the training areas is on a first come first served basis (except for the lottery system during the general deer season).
- Training area availability for hunting is determined by the military training schedule. There may be times when hunting opportunities are extremely limited or unavailable due to military training requirements.
- Reduced Fee applicants (Military, Veterans, Retirees and Youth) must submit a copy of their DD214, front of valid CAC card or reduced fee CDFW hunting license with their application to verify reduced fee eligibility.
- Military applicants must submit a copy of their Common Access Card (front only) with their application to verify fee eligibility.
- All sales are final and are not refundable or transferable between individuals, or to another permit year.
- Fees are administered in the following manner: conservation fees are used for habitat/wildlife management; activity fees cover program administration, processing and management.
- **ALL** weapons used on FHL must be registered with Directorate of Emergency Services using Form 8 **BEFORE** use on FHL per Army Regulation 190-11. **DO NOT** bring weapons onto cantonment until registered with Form 8 which can be found on FHL Hunting website at:



- 1** Must submit DD214 or VA ID Card with a copy of drivers license or state ID
- 2** Permit applicant must be a military member on active duty status E7 and above to include Officers, or Retiree (submit copy of CAC Card or Blue Retiree ID Card)
- 3** Permit applicant must be a military member on active duty status E5-E6 (submit copy of CAC Card)
- 4** Permit applicant must present a copy of a CDFW youth hunting license.
- 5** Permit applicant must be a military member on active duty status E4 or below (submit copy of CAC Card)
- 6** Will require permit if selected. Application fee will be applied to permit cost. No additional preference points will be awarded following year.
