Fort Hunter Liggett roads temporarily closed due to unsafe conditions

FORT HUNTER LIGGETT, Calif. – Some roads on and through Fort Hunter Liggett are closed due to safety concerns for travelers.

The following roads are closed to all public traffic:

- The Nacimiento-Ferguson Road is closed through mid January 2011 because the Green Bridge is undergoing required repairs and the low water crossing is not safe for general use or passage; and,
- The two low water crossings on Del Venturi have been closed, probably through spring, until the water recedes to a safe level.
